1 Corinthians 11: 23 – 26

Financial Corner

What do you think is the most important part of a plan? It's the seed. Seeds vary in size from the 20,000 tiny seeds in a tobacco pod to a 22 pound coconut. Yet, the size of the seed doesn't determine the size of the plant. For example, the tallest tree in the world, the California Redwood, grows from a very small seed, while the large seed from a watermelon produces a short, creeping vine.
